No Community Eclipse Monkey



- The Eclipse Monkey component of the Dash Project was originally created by Ward and Bjorn in March 2006 as one of their “a little technology, a little process, and a little community” efforts to help the Eclipse developer community.
- Monkey gained some users but never found a core developer team to maintain and improve it.
- There has been no major work on Eclipse Monkey for more than a year and even before that the work was mostly refactoring the existing code for better modularization.
- There are eight posts in the newsgroup in the last year, three of which are “is this project still alive?”.

- There are a few dozens of posts on the mailing list, but none are of the form “I’ll work on Monday as a committer”.

Archiving Eclipse Monkey (1)



- The actions to be taken to archive the Eclipse Monkey component of the Dash project:
 - Zip up and remove these directories from the CVS:
 - org.eclipse.dash.domifier
 - org.eclipse.dash.doms
 - org.eclipse.eclipsemonkey
 - org.eclipse.eclipsemonkey.*
 - org.eclipse.eclipsemonkey-feature
 - org.eclipse.eclipsemonkey-site
 - org.mozilla.javascript
 - org.mozilla.rhino
 - org.mozilla.rhino-feature

Archiving Eclipse Monkey (2)



- The actions to be taken to archive the Eclipse Monkey component of the Dash project:
 - Archive and remove these dash website files and directories:
 - dash/monkey/*
 - dash/monkey*
 - Note the 33 currently open bugs under Dash > Eclipse monkey as “this component is being archived and thus this bug is being marked as WONTFIX”. Then mark them as WONTFIX.
 - Archive and close for further submission the Dash > Eclipse monkey bugzilla component.
