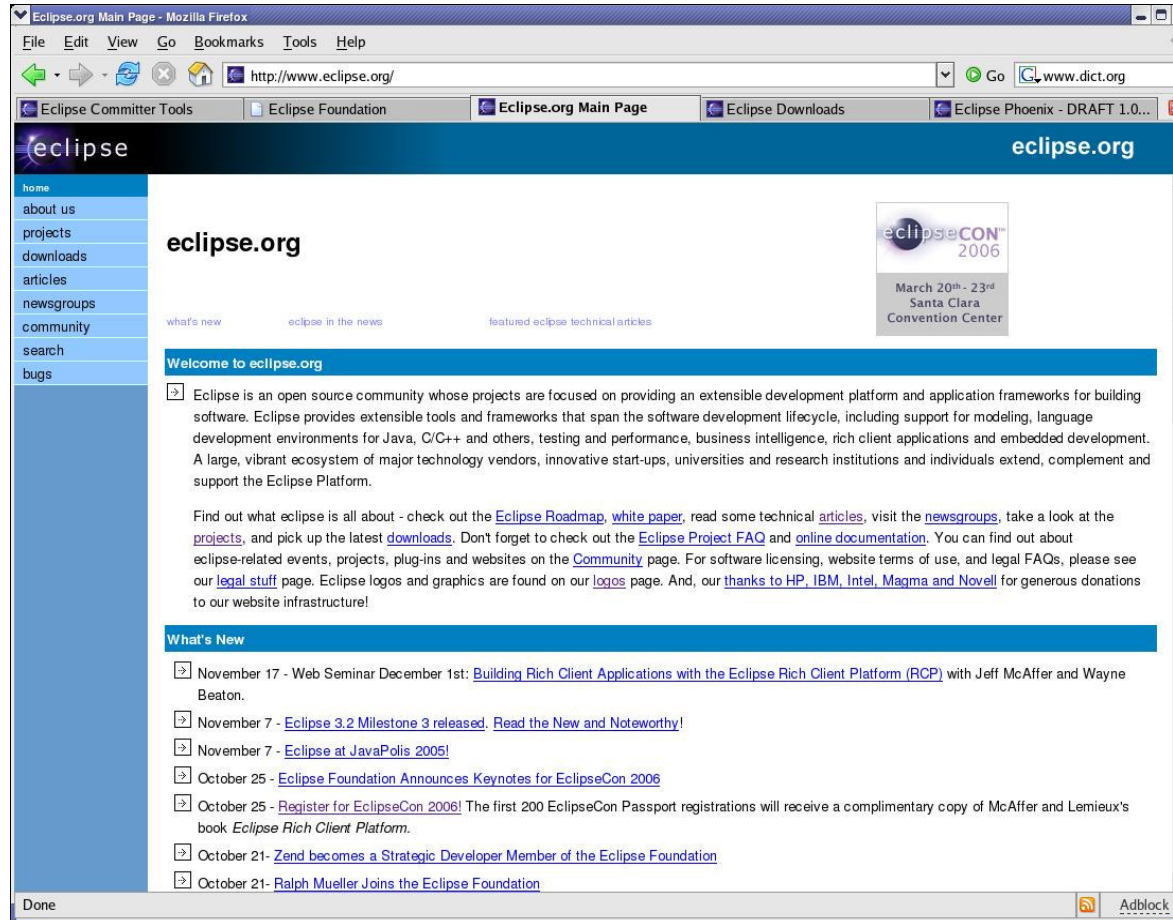

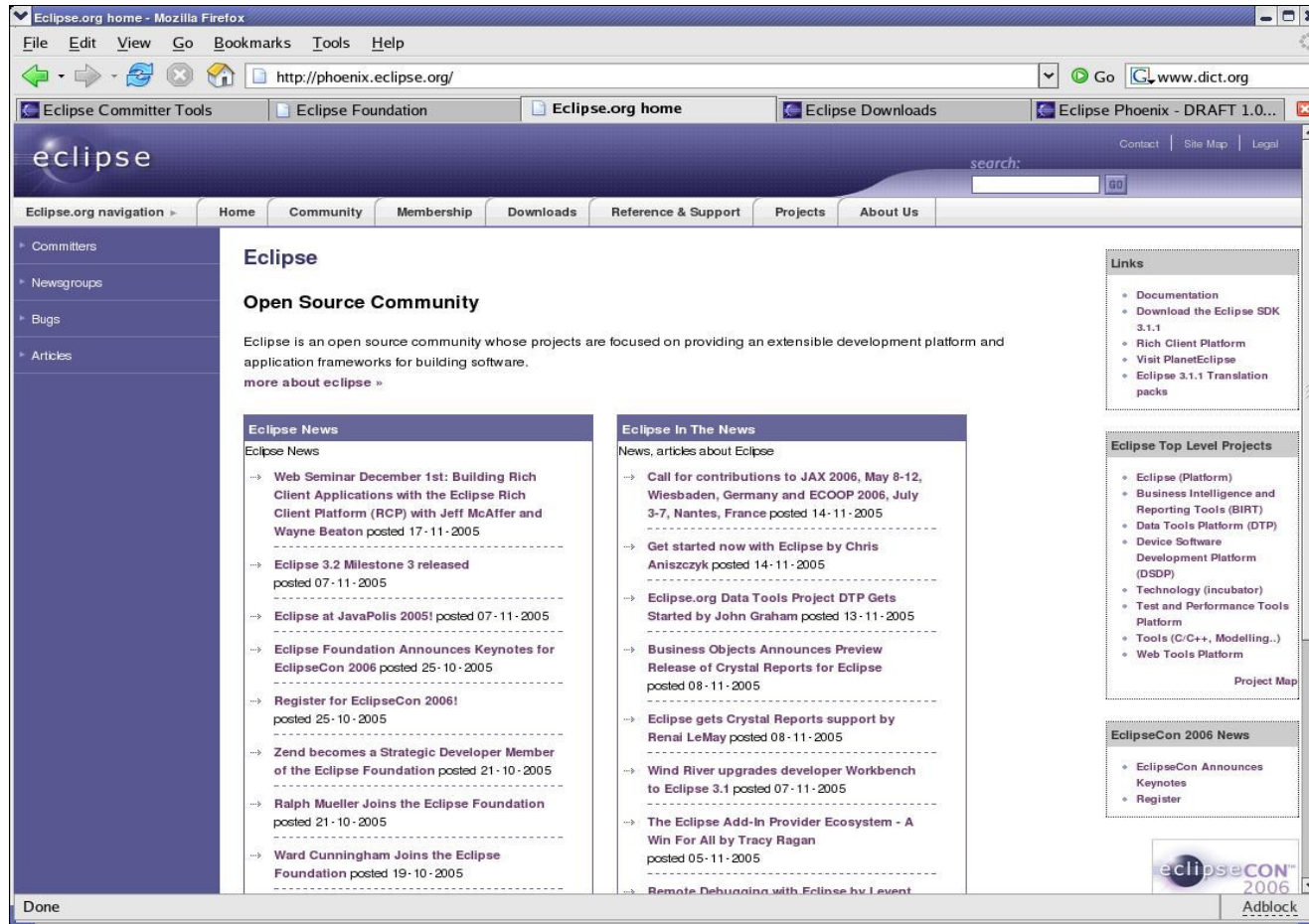

New Site Features

- No more frames!
- Flexible websites with PHP support
- URL compatibility with redirects
- Simple URLs for easy linking
- Easy to “skin” with themes – change the look and feel of the entire site with minutes
- Low infrastructure overhead



How to build a website using Phoenix

- Download the Phoenix Starter Kit (<http://eclipse.org/default/phoenix-starter-kit.zip>)
- Extract the starter kit to your Eclipse project's workspace
- Edit the `_projectCommon.php` file to select your theme and define navigation links for your project
- Copy the `template.php` file and add your HTML content
- Commit the changes to your Eclipse CVS website
