Proposed new project under the RAP project

- Goal: experiment with alternative ideas and technologies
- Allows us to take advantage of Foundation IP guidelines for projects under incubation
 - Notably, more agile process around section 4 of the Intellectual Property Policy ("DUE DILIGENCE AND RECORD KEEPING")
- Clearly separates experimental, forward-looking work from "mainline" development on the RAP code base.

Scope



- Experiment with alternative ideas and technologies for enhancing and complementing RAP
 - alternative client technologies
 - integration with other techologies
 - additional components and tools for RAP
- Only those efforts that have potential to graduate
 - "It is not a playground".
- Investment in the incubator must never leave the community with the perception that it is coming at the cost of important work on the RAP project.

 - mulit-page CSS editor to assist with development of theme files
 - by Mathias Schäffner (GSoC 2008)
- GC Canvas widget
 - custom widget for drawing operations
 - by Mirko Solazzi
- Google Visualization widgets for RAP
 - 10 new widgets for RAP that use the Google Visualization API
 - by David Donohue
