### Third Party Software Reused By STP Not Distributed

STP needs these third-party packages to function correctly, but STP doesn't distribute them. Instead they are picked up from Eclipse projects upon which STP depends.

### Third Party Software Required By STP Not Distributed

Some components of STP require software capabilities that are not distributed with STP. These dependencies are usually on other Open Source projects that implement runtime elements that the tools leverage.

- The ServiceCreation component's JAXWS capabilities can be realized by the Apache CXF or the SUN JAXWS Reference Implementation runtimes.
- The ServiceCreation component's SCA capabilities can be realized by the Apache Tuscany runtime.
- The SCA component's capabilities can be realized by the Apache Tuscany or Frascati runtimes.
